EXCURSION TO MITTENWALD AND ETTAL

The excursion to Würzburg being cancelled for a variety of reasons, we are happy to offer an excellent alternative:

The picturesque Land of Werdenfels extends from Oberammergau, Murnau, Mittenwald to Garmisch-Partenkirchen, it borders Tirol in the South and culminates in Germany's highest alpine peaks, the ranges of the Zugspitze, the Karwendel- and the Wettersteinmountains. Because of its extraordinary beauty the Land of Werdenfels is also called the "Golden Landl".

We shall have a special guided tour in the Violin-Museum by the Vice Director of the Geigenbauschule in Mittenwald, Mr. Neuner, giving us detailed and first hand information on a number of highly interesting details on the manufacture of violins.

After an extended lunch break at the traditional Inn "Mittenwalder Alpenrose", we shall go by bus to the Benedictine Abbey in Ettal. It owes its foundation in the year 1330 to the Duke of Bavaria Ludwig IV, at the same time Roman Emperor of the German Nation, widely known as the "Bavarian".

We shall end the day with a snack or dinner at the "Murnauer Griesbräu" before our return to Munich.

VISIT OF THE EXHIBITION "MAY THE LAND OF BAVARIA BLOSSOM FOREVER – DUKE LUDWIG X and the RENAISSANCE"

This second excursion before the summer vacations will take us in Landshut to the castle Trausnitz, which was nearly completed by 1235, when Emperor Frederic II stayed as guest in Landshut.

We shall have lunch at the Augustiner in Landshut after the guided tour in the castle.

We shall then visit the exhibition "May the Land of Bavaria blossom forever – Duke Ludwig X and the Renaissance". We shall learn how Duke Ludwig X (1495-1545) imported the Renaissance to Bavaria. The exhibition comprises of over 200 precious artifacts of tapestry, sculptures, medals and print media in the historic state halls of the town residence at Landshut.

We shall have coffee at the restaurant "Zur Insel" and shall leave for Munich around 16.30 hrs.
