Our weekly Stammtisch will continue in September on all Thursdays (02, 09, 16, 23, and 30) at 12 noon at the "Bacchus Keller" of the Ratskeller for all members, their friends and guests. We will be happy if you attend.

**VISIT OF THE OTTO KING OF GREECE MUSEUM**

We are planning to visit the Otto König von Griechenland Museum of the municipality of Ottobrunn on the afternoon of **Wednesday, September 8, 2010**. We are very pleased that the founder of the museum, Professor Dr. med. Jan Murken, has agreed to make himself available for a tour of the museum and to show us its treasures.

The Otto König von Griechenland Museum is located in the Ottobrunn Town Hall. However, the emphasis of the Museum is less on the history of the community of Ottobrunn but more on the activities of King Otto I in Greece. The collection encompasses more than 200 objects related to the topics of Panhellenism, the Greeks' fight for independence, the development of liberated Greece under Otto I, views of the capitals of Nauplia (twin town of Ottobrunn) and Athens, as well as beautiful commodities from the Court of Otto I, e.g. silver and porcelain from the royal banquet table plus timepieces and jewelry from Otto's personal assets. Special mention must be made of the picture gallery of the Museum with oil paintings and watercolors by artists such as Hess, Heideck and Perlberg, as well as graphic art by Schinkel and Rottmann, among others.

Our visit starts at 3 p.m. We will meet at 2:50 p.m. in front of the Museum in Ottobrunn at No. 1, Rathausplatz. The most convenient way to get there, apart from using your car, is by S-Bahn Line No.7 to Aying, leaving Marienplatz Station at 2:11 p.m., arriving at Neuperlach Süd Station at 2:28 p.m. There you would have to change to Regional Bus Line No. 210 in the direction of "Taufkirchen, Lilienthalstraße", leaving at 2:33 p.m. arriving at "Ottobrunn, Ortsmitte" stop at 2:41 p.m. From there, it is only a short walk of approximately 300 meters to the town hall in the center of town. In order to get there, you will have to walk down Putzbrunnerstraße about 200 meters and then turn right into Rathausstraße.

After the tour of the museum and weather permitting,, we have planned a visit to the outdoor "Aquarium" beer garden at the Ottobrunner Ratsstuben, otherwise we will be indoors.

An entrance fee to the museum of Euro 5.- will have to be paid at the door. The cost for the subsequent snack is at everybody's own expense.

As usual, our ladies are very welcome to join us in this visit. Please be aware that the total number of participants is limited to 35. Registration is required with Dr. Peter Rückert not later than Monday, August 30, 2010, letting him know at the same time if you will stay for the beer garden. We request your understanding that we can only consider registrations in writing. Places are allocated strictly in the order of registrations received.

**VISIT OF THE MUNICH OKTOBERFEST**  
**SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, FROM 12 NOON TILL 5:45 P.M.**

As mentioned in our July program, we again have been able to secure 50 seats for our Club at the Hacker tent on the second "Wies'n" Sunday, September 26, 2010.

This year, Munich celebrates the 200<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Oktoberfest. On October 1810, a large fair and horse races were held on the occasion of the marriage of the Bavarian heir to the throne. The people of Munich took to the celebrations so enthusiastically that from then on they were repeated

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every year. But only at the turn to the 20<sup>th</sup> century the Oktoberfest became the famous folk festival which it is today. In our opinion, the above anniversary date should be a must for the Men's Club.

Like last year, seats have been allocated to us in the very nice Seitenboxe (side box) no. 9 from 12 noon till 5:45 p.m. If you are taking part, please come to the tent in time. The box has been reserved on behalf of Deutsch-Amerikanischer Herrenclub München e.V. by Dr. Peter Rückert.

When registering, please use the enclosed form and send it to Dr. Peter Rückert before September 12, 2010 and, at the same time, transfer the amount of Euro 32.- for vouchers (entitling you to 2 liters of beer, half a roast chicken and Euro 5.- for incidentals) to our Club account no. 1740 117 366 at the Hypo Vereinsbank, BLZ 700 202 70. Only members who have registered in writing and paid the price for the vouchers can be considered for admission. Allocations are made in the order of incoming registrations.

Please understand that it will not be possible to make a binding reservation for our box without the concurrent purchase of the vouchers. Therefore, amounts paid by individuals cannot be refunded. If you are prevented unexpectedly to attend after registration and payment, you will receive your vouchers for possible redemption in the following week. They can also be settled against the charge for food and drink at the "Gasthof zum Wildpark" in Straßlach, daily except on Sundays and holidays, until the end of November.

The vouchers are available to you on Sunday, September 26, from 11:45 a.m. at the Seitenboxe No. 9. The entrance tickets to the tent will be mailed to you in time.
